We have scheduled our annual meeting for Thursday, November 9, 2023 beginning at 7:00 pm. It will be held at the Grandwood Park Community Center which is located at 36630 N. Hutchins Road. All homeowners are encouraged to attend, however if you are unable to attend, your Board has a favor to ask. On behalf of your fellow Board members, we thank you for all your hard work and dedication in serving our community Michael. Also, Mary Biagini stepped down for the Board earlier this year and we thank her for her contributions as well. We would like to welcome our newest member of the Board, Brian Maschek who joined earlier this year. With the addition of Brian, we still have one seat on the Board open and highly encourage you to consider joining the Board. As a reminder, our Shires HOA is a self-managed association which allows us to keep our assessments very reasonable. If we do not have enough volunteers, we will be forced to engage a professional management company and preliminary information leads us to believe our annual assessments may double or perhaps go even higher to pay for this service, so please consider joining the Board.

Finally, we have a couple of quick reminders regarding some rules, regulations and general information. The best way to contact your Board is via our website at Shireshome.com, since we rarely use our P.O. Box outside of the annual assessment payment time. We have also been told the Lake County Sheriff's office has been ticketing cars parked overnight on the street because overnight parking is prohibited in our subdivision. Two other areas of note is a reminder that garbage and recycling cans are not to be visible from the street and commercial vehicles, recreational vehicles, snow mobiles, boats, trailers or other similar vehicles may not be parked in driveways for more than twenty-four (24) hours at a time
